
Goose Creek


This makes a 12" block 12.5 unfinished.



Think Scrappy!



You will need $18-2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make 2-9 patch squares. Start by sewing TWO nine patch blocks as shown at left, using 1/4' seams. Press row seams in alternating directions. These should measure 6-1/2" when done, trim them if needed...



Cut the triangles from two 3-7/8" squares of "dark" fabric, and the center square is a 4-3/4" "light" square! Press seams towards outer triangles. This should measure 6-1/2". Trim back if needed...



Now just piece the block! Make rows, then sew the rows together, again using 1/4" seams. Press row seams in alternating directions. All Done! :0)
