Half-Square Triangle BOM Quilt Along - Block 1




Our first block is a slight variation on the traditional Sawtooth Star quilt block.

Materials:


- (8) 4" squares from background fabric (white)
- (4) 4" squares from print fabric (green)
- (2) 4" squares from second print fabric (orange)
- (2) 4" squares from third print fabric (yellow)

- 1. Assemble your half-square triangles using the traditional method (explained on the intoduction sheet). Press seams open.
- 2. Trim your half-square triangles to 3.5" square. This is an important step to help make sure your block turns out square.



3. Arrange your half-square triangles as shown in the image above.

- 4. Sew your half-square triangles into four rows. Press seams open (alternately, you can press your seams in opposite directions for each row so that your seams nest together).
- 5. Sew your four rows together, pinning where the seams match up.





6. Press seams open. Trim block to 12.5" if necessary.
