Awards at the Fairs

The Guild has given two awards for quilts entered in the local fairs. The Dorrie Whipple Award is given for excellence in Machine Quilting at the Sonoma County Fair. The other award is the Joyce Gross Award of Excellence given at the Sonoma-Marin Fair. Joyce was regarded as one of the nation's most important historians of 20th century quilts and quilt makers. She was a quilter, teacher, lecturer, editor of a quilt newsletter, and collector of all things concerning quilts. Joyce was an honorary Lifetime member of the Petaluma Quilt Guild that sponsors this award. Her quilt collection resides at the Briscoe Center for American History at the University of Texas in Austin. Joyce was named a "National Treasure" by the Alliance for American Quilts, and was inducted into the Quilters Hall of Fame in 1996.

Many of you have been contributing beautiful items for the boutique, volunteering for the quilt show committee, and working on beautiful quilts for display at the show and we thank you for all your hard work and contributions.



Quilt Show! First we need your quilts and similar items to display. Be sure and submit your quilts by first completing an entry form for each item and submitting them at the September Guild meeting or mailing them to the Guild post office address listed on the entry from by the deadline, September 24. Be sure and include a \$5.00 check for the first to fifth entry. You can submit quilts, wall quilts, or quilted items such as table runners, bags, pillows, vests, jackets, etc. The Quilt entry from is available on our web site or call Sharon J. and one will be mailed to you. The items

submitted do not have to be new or made by you so if you have a treasured vintage quilt you would like to submit, please do.

Entry to the Quilt Show is \$5.00 per person and an arm band will make it possible to come and go throughout the day. **Quilt Guild members who volunteer get free entry** and there will be a room set aside just for volunteers to rest and take breaks.

Awards! This year we will be having Viewer's Choice voting on favorite quilts. The categories are art and wearable (this category is for any submission that isn't a quilt), appliquéd, pieced, and made by someone under 16 years old. Attendees will vote for their favorites and we will award ribbons for first, second, and third in each category. The item that has the most votes of all will receive Best of Show. All awards will be selected by 3:30 pm and ribbons awarded that day. Be sure to invite the young quilters you know and anyone who is a quilter or maker of quilting type items. Family, friends and neighbors are welcome to come to the event and the more attendees the better.

Raffle Prizes! You all will have the opportunity to win prizes with our raffles for gift certificates, donated items from quilting companies and the Crazy Quilt.
