

Half-Square Triangle BOM Quilt Along - Block 1



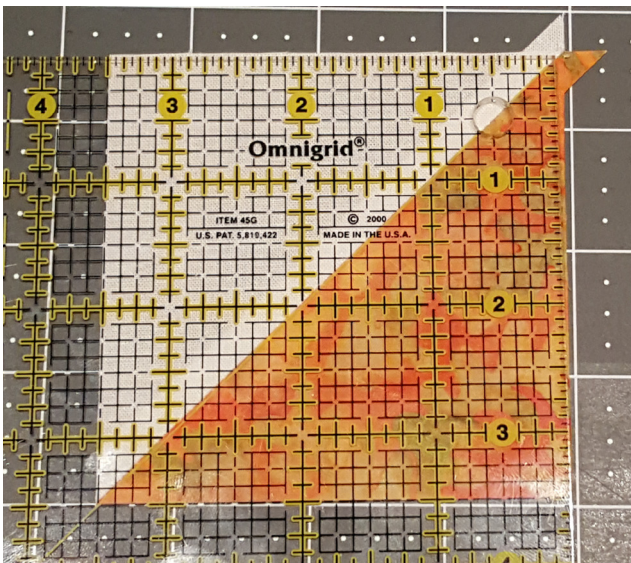
Our first block is a slight variation on the traditional Sawtooth Star quilt block.

Materials:

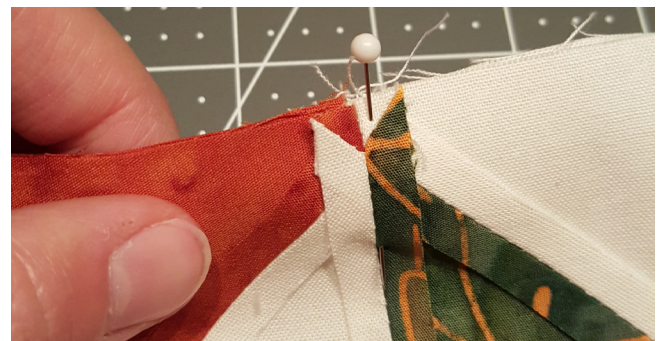
- (8) 4" squares from background fabric (white)
- (4) 4" squares from print fabric (green)
- (2) 4" squares from second print fabric (orange)
- (2) 4" squares from third print fabric (yellow)

1. Assemble your half-square triangles using the traditional method (explained on the introduction sheet). Press seams open.
2. Trim your half-square triangles to 3.5" square. This is an important step to help make sure your block turns out square.

4. Sew your half-square triangles into four rows. Press seams open (alternately, you can press your seams in opposite directions for each row so that your seams nest together).
5. Sew your four rows together, pinning where the seams match up.



3. Arrange your half-square triangles as shown in the image above.



6. Press seams open. Trim block to 12.5" if necessary.
