Block of the Month - May 2017

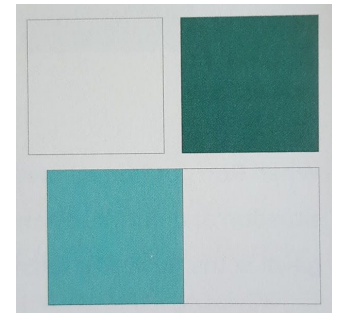


Fabric Requirements:

- (2) 5" squares of white fabric
- (2) 5" squares of pattern fabric

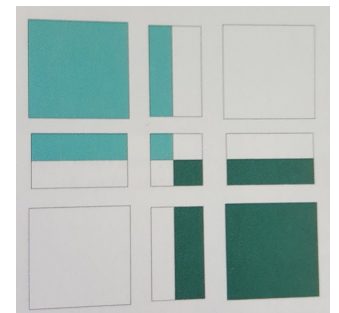
Step 1:

Sew a white 5" square to a print 5" square. Make 2 and press the seams toward the darker fabric. Sew them together into a 4 patch.



Step 2:

Place the 1" line of a rotary cutting ruler vertically on the center seam line. Cut along the edge of the ruler. Turn the cutting mat or your block without disturbing the pieces. Place the 1" line of the ruler on the center seam line and cut along the edge. Continue on in this manner until you have made 4 cuts.



Step 3:

Swap the large squares at the top and bottom of the block. Rotate the center square 90°. See image at the top.

Step 4:

Sew the pieces back together into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.
