## Petaluma Quilt Guild Membership Quiltlets

## What is a Quiltet?

A quiltet is a small, finished quilt - approximately the size of a regular quilt block. As with a normal quilt, the item has a backing, batting \& top and the sides are bound. Quilting can be by machine or hand.

Let your quiltlet speak for you. This is an opportunity to show off your favourite technique, a sampling from your stash or to try something new. Our goal is to connect our quiltlets together and demonstrate to ourselves and our visitors the power of our creativity. Finished quiltlets will be used during our outreach at community events and quilt shows.

## Quiltlet Instructions

* The design of the quiltlet is totally up to you. For display please use the following format guidelines.
* Finished quiltlets measure $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
** Finish the top \& bottom of the quiltet with a $1 / 4$ " wide binding. The two sides will have the same $1 / 4$ " wide binding, but the ends of the binding need to extend to form ties (see diagram).
* Please note on the back of your quiltlet, your name, the year you joined the Guild and any other interesting information you wish to share.
