ARROWHEAD PUZZLE


Color 1 - Red Color 2 - Blue Color 3 -White/Off White This makes a 16" block !



July2021 Military Block of the Month

Cut the Color 1 4-1/2" x 27" strip of fabric into six 4-1/2" squares. Cut the Color 2 4-1/2" x 9" strip into two 4-1/2" squares. Cut the Color 3 4-1/2" x 36" strip into eight 4-1/2" squares...



Using the standard <u>scant 1/4" seam</u> <u>allowance</u> sew one each of the four rows show at left. Press seams in alternating directions by row. Sew the rows together and your block is complete! Good Job!!


Emancipated Foster Youth Baskets
