
Antique Tiles Fall 2021 Military block. This block will finish to 12 ¹/₂

Supply list:Color 1 Red
Color 2 Blueone $2 \frac{1}{2} x 10^{\circ}$ strip and one $2 \frac{1}{2} x 18^{\circ}$ strip shown in the dark blue
one $2 \frac{1}{2} x10^{\circ}$ strip and one $2 \frac{1}{2} x 18^{\circ}$ strip and one $4 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ square
Color 3 WhiteColor 2 $\frac{1}{2} x 18^{\circ}$ strip

CUTTING::







Start by marking and cutting the Color 1 red (shown in dark blue) and Color 2 blue 2-1/2" x 10" strips into four 2-1/2" squares of each...

Next mark and cut the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 18 " strips of Colors 1 red (shown in dark blue), 2 blue and 3 white into four 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ rectangles of each...


SEWING:

Sew the Color 1 RED (shown in dark blue) and Color 2 BLUE right sides together in Pairs. Press seam to darker You will make four sets...




Sew Color 2 BLUE rectangles to the side of the square

pairs... two on the left and then two on the right with Color 1 RED (shown in dark blue) square on the bottom in each pair. These will be the block's four corner units. You will be making 2 sets that are opposite.



Sew Color 1 red & Color 3 white rectangles right sides together in pairs along one long edge, again using a scant 1/4" seam. Press seam to darker side. Make four units for the block's sides...



Now piece the block! Lay out all your units as shown at left, then sew three horizontal rows. Press top and bottom row seams towards the outsides, and center row seam towards the middle. ...and then join the rows!

This is shown in blue and white, but I want it to be red where the dark blue is shown, white and blue for a military block.
