Make a Duck Tracks Quilt Block From our Free Quilt Block Pattern Library

If it walks like a duck...

Quacks like a duck...

It must be... a Duck Tracks quilt block!

Use a colorful background and solids for then star. Make the 12 ½" unfinished size




Supply List:

Red (Color 1) – one $2 \% \times 10^{\circ}$ strip and one $2 \% \times 18^{\circ}$ strip (shown in dark blue)


Blue (Color 2) – one $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 10^{\circ}$ strip, one $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 18^{\circ}$ strip, and one $4 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ square (shown in blue and white pattern)

White (Color 3) – one $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 18^{\circ}$ strip (shown in white)



Start by marking and cutting the **Color 1** and **Color 2** 2 ½" x 10" strips into four 2 ½" squares of each

Mark and cut the 2 ½ x 18 " strips of **Colors** 1, 2 and 3 into four 2 ½ x 4 ½ rectangles of each






Sew the Color 1 and Color 2 right sides together in pairs. Press seam towards Color 1. You will make four sets.



Sew **Color 2** rectangles to the side of the square pairs. Two on the left and then two on the right with **Color 1** square on the bottom in each pair. These will be the block's four corner units. You will be making 2 sets that are opposite.

Sew Color 1 and Color 3 rectangles right sides together in pairs along one long edge, again using a scant ¼" seam. Press seam to Color 1. Make four units for the block's sides



Lay out all your units as shown below, then sew three horizontal rows.

Press top and bottom row seams towards the outsides, and center row seam towards the middle. Then join the rows.

Program: Shannon and Sally and the holiday committee put on a great show. The guild had to give a big round of applause for their work to make a great meeting.






