Approval of the minutes from past meeting – Minutes from March meeting were approved by e-mail by the board on 3-15-23.

President: Debby L. will be unable to attend the June 6 PQG meeting; 2nd VP Program Julie S offered to chair the meeting. The May board meeting will be held May 4. In compliance with the PQG bylaws, a nominating committee will convene in May to nominate a new Executive Board of Directors; the slate of officers will be presented at the June meeting. The most current version of the Bylaws and Membership Application needs to be added to the PQG website, Debby will check on

The Attorney General has changed the raffle registration year for nonprofits to the calendar year. This will extend the PQG raffle permit to December 31 with the raffle report due February 1, 2024.

Membership: Debby clarified that new members are added to the eblast and newsletter lists. Marilyn will make these changes when she receives a new member's application and dues.

Programs: Julie indicated that the May speaker is Joe Cunningham, and that the June program is an ice cream social and a Mystery Quilt Challenge. Julie is lining up

speakers for July and August and will attend the Northern California Quilt Council to get ideas for future speakers.

Ways and Means: Sharon J will chair the committee to complete the House Opportunity Quilt. A chair is needed to coordinate efforts to market the Opportunity Quilt to the community. Sue D will print tickets and set up volunteers for the booth at the Sonoma-Marin Fair in Petaluma June 21-25. The PQG needs a chair for the Ways and Means Committee.

Call Meeting to Order

-The meeting was called to order at 7:06 PM by Sue D - 28 Members and 7 guests present.

Minutes of the March 7, 2023 General Meeting - a motion was made to approve the minutes as circulated in the March Newsletter; the minutes were approved with no additions or corrections.

President's News- First Vice President Sue D called the meeting to order and welcomed members and guests. The president of the Napa Quilt Guild shared their opportunity quilt, Welcome to the Hen House. Tickets are available for \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00. The drawing will be December 9. Sue D asked the group if they wanted to change the July Meeting to July 11 due to the conflict with July 4. The group agreed to change the

Hello all -


