



Petaluma Quilt Guild Board Meeting Minutes

June 8, 2023

Meeting called to order at: 4:40 PM

Board Members present: Debby L, President; Sue D, 1st Vice Present Membership; Julie S, 2nd Vice President Program; Marilyn F, Treasurer; Shari K, Secretary.

Approval of the minutes from past meeting – The board did not meet in May, notes from email communication were included in the June newsletter. The board voted by email to have a booth in the Art and Garden Festival on July 9 in downtown Petaluma.

President:

The board voted to host a social in the spring and invite the Santa Rosa Quilt Guild and the Moonlighters. The event will be both a social and a fundraiser. Debby L will chair and recruit a committee.

The nominating committee has submitted the names for President and Treasurer, the current 1st VP for Membership, 2nd VP for Program and Secretary have agreed to run for a second term. The PQG will participate in the Art and Garden Festival on July 9. The festival is held in downtown Petaluma from 11 AM to 5 PM on Kentucky St, 4th St, B St, and A St parking lot. Volunteers are still needed for 12:30 to 2:00 and 2:30 to 5:00PM shifts. Contact Debby L if you can volunteer to work.

Military Quilts – Jayne brought quilts that needed binding. The binding has already been made and needs to be sewn by machine or hand. By the end of the meeting, all quilts had been taken!

Block of the Month – There was no Block of the month, save your block for next month.

Friendship Blocks – Blocks can be appliqué or pieced.

Program – Julie S shared that there are guest speakers for July and August, and September could be a Challenge program.

Mystery Quilt – The mystery quilt was a success with 9 entries. Garnet won 3rd place, Jo 2nd place and Marilyn F first place. All the entries were very creative!
